BE IT RESOLVED:

THE TOWNSHIP OF WATERLOO HEREBY ADOPTS

AS A TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE THE MARINE SAFETY ACT,  
ACT 303 - PUBLIC ACT OF 1967 AS AMENDED THROUGH  
MAY 19, 1992.

A VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE PUNISHABLE BY A FINE  
NOT TO EXCEED \$500.00 AND/OR A JAIL SENTENCE OF NOT MORE  
THAN 90 DAYS.

THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE THIRTY (30) DAYS AFTER  
ITS PUBLICATION IN THE NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION.

UNDER SECTION OF THE ACT THAT PROVIDES THAT " LOCAL POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS MAY ENACT AS AN ORDINANCE ANY AND ALL OF SECTION 2 to 8, 31 to 33, 36, 61, 62, 71 to 79, 101, 151, 152 and 161 to 168 .CL 282.1017

Any other rules governing Water Ways must be submitted to the Department of Natural Resources within 60 days for approval.
