

**ORDINANCE FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE 1996
NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE**

Ordinance No. 09-12-15-6

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE MINIMUM REGULATION GOVERNING THE DESIGN, INSTALLATION AND CONSTRUCTION OF ELECTRICAL SYSTEMS, BY PROVIDING REASONABLE SAFEGUARDS FOR SANITATION TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY AGAINST THE HAZARDS OF INADEQUATE, DEFECTIVE OR UNSAFE ELECTRICAL SYSTEMS AND INSTALLATIONS, KNOWN AS THE ELECTRICAL CODE;

Be it ordained by the Township of Waterloo as follows:

SECTION 1. ADOPTION OF ELECTRICAL CODE.

That a certain document, three (3) copies of which are on file in the office of the Township Clerk of the Township of Waterloo, being marked and designated as the "National Electrical Code 1996" as published by the National Fire Protection Association be and is hereby adopted as the Electrical Code of the Township of Waterloo in the State of Michigan, for the control of buildings and structures as herein provided; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said National Electrical Code are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof, as if fully set out in this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES REPEALED.

That Ordinance Number 93-07-20-02 of the Township of Waterloo entitled Ordinance for Adoption of the 1993 National Electrical Code, and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. SAVING CLAUSE.

That nothing in this Ordinance or in the Electrical Code hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding impending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing under any act or ordinance hereby repealed as cited in Section 2 of this Ordinance; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. DATE OF EFFECT.

That the Township Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and cause the same to be published as required by law; and this Ordinance shall take full force

and effect 30 days after this date of final passage and approval.
