

**WATERLOO TOWNSHIP BOARD RESOLUTION TO ENACT AN ORDINANCE TO  
REGULATE SPECIAL EVENTS**

Minutes of a Regular Board meeting of the Township Board of Waterloo Township,  
Jackson County, Michigan, held at the Township Hall in said Township on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of  
May, 2004, at 7:38 P m., Local Time.

The following resolution was offered by Robert Hannwald and  
seconded by Ron Bayer:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The following Ordinance is hereby adopted:

**WATERLOO TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE**

**ORDINANCE NO: 04-05-18-3**

**SPECIAL EVENT ORDINANCE**

Section (1)

As used in this section, "special event" means an organized event involving more than 10 people which will use township streets or sidewalks. It includes, but is not limited to, events by foot, bicycle, motor vehicle, skateboard, roller skates or wheelchair.

Section (2)

No person shall organize, promote, stage or sponsor any special event in the township using streets or sidewalks without first obtaining a permit from the township and without complying with the conditions of the permit.

Section (3)

Application for a permit shall be made on forms prescribed by the township. The forms may require information on the event's location, time, medical facilities, safety equipment and such other information as the township may need to determine whether a permit should be issued. Permits shall be granted or refused based on the safety and welfare of the participants, the public and on the degree of interference with the use of the streets for public travel.

Section (4)

The granting of a permit may be conditioned upon proof of insurance protecting the township, agreements to indemnify the township, liability waivers, and payment of the costs of providing needed police assistance or other forms of township assistance.

Section (5)

No permit for a competitive event shall be refused because of the political or religious beliefs of the participants.

Section (6)

Any person or entity who shall violate any of the terms of this Ordinance, shall upon conviction in a court of competent jurisdiction, be guilty of a misdemeanor and be subject to a fine of not more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars and/or imprisonment of not more than ninety (90) days.

Section (7)


The township may adopt regulations to facilitate the enforcement of this section.

Section (8)


