

Ordinance number 02-04-23-1

An ordinance to designate an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the Township of Waterloo located in Jackson County, under the provisions of the State Construction Code Act, Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972 as amended.

The Township of Waterloo ordains:

Section 1. Waterloo Township. Pursuant to the provisions of the Michigan Building Code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972 as amended, the Building, Electrical, Mechanical or Plumbing Official of the Township of Waterloo is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the Waterloo Township under Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, State of Michigan. The Township of Waterloo assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Act throughout its corporate limits.


Section 2. REPEALS, All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. PUBLICATION. This ordinance shall be effective after legal publication and in accordance with provisions of the Act governing same.
